

François Champsaur, the leading French interior designer from Marseille, has emerged from a six-month project perfecting the décor of Hotel Le Bailli de Suffren down to the very last detail. Tucked away in one of the most well preserved bays of the Gulf of St. Tropez, the hotel has 55 spacious guestrooms of different categories, with either a balcony or a terrace that opens up to a view of the Golden Islands and the Mediterranean.

François Champsaur found inspiration in the distinct geographical aspects of the hotel: its border with the Mediterranean, the interiors bathed in natural light, and pristine natural surroundings. The hotel is also a stone's throw away from the Jardins du Rayol, a wonderful botanical garden and arboretum of Mediterranean plants.

Champsaur wanted to bring the spirit of the south to this classic 1960s-1970s waterfront edifice nestled between the rocks by mixing different materials like wood, terracotta, ceramic, cotton and wicker to create a gentle, poetic ambiance.
